

## TIPS FOR PEDIATRIC CRANIAL TRAUMATISM

Head injuries are always serious accidents, especially if accompanied by:

- Initial loss of consciousness
- Nosebleed, earbleed
- Hematoma around the eyes
- Vomiting

The examination date by the physician of the medical center didn't show any worrying sign. Your child is allowed to return home, but you have to take care of him, and you have to follow these advices :

- Do not leave your child alone at home
- Call the doctor urgently or call 112: If the child complains of severe headaches, vomiting, ih he has blurred vision, difficulty to speak, or any other worrying or if you notice abnormal sleepiness
- Call 112 if your child as unconscious movements of limbs, if he has loss of consciousness, or if you have difficulties to wake your child.

In any case, if he has headaches or little dizziness, he has to stay in bed. Do not give him medication and avoid violent games or sudden movements.
