

ADVICES AFTER A HEAD TRAUMATISM

You just had a head traumatism, without loss of consciousness. The favorable results of the examinations allowed you to go back home. However, some rare complications require monitoring during the hours following the trauma.

If you have:

- Headaches
- Nausea or vomiting
- Drowsiness or consciousness disorders
- Dizziness or blurred vision
- Difficulties in mobilizing a member or a finger

You need to see a doctor as fast as possible!
